

# Conflict Minerals Policy

Yokohama Electronic Devices Co., Ltd. will drive prohibiting the use of tantalum, tin, gold and tungsten (hereinafter referred to as conflict minerals) mined at the Democratic Republic of the Congo and its adjacent countries in the source of fund for armed groups who have repeatedly engaged in inhuman activities such as human trafficking, forced labor, child labor, abuse.

Yokohama Electronic Devices Co., Ltd. will promote the following initiatives in order to comply with this policy.

1. We conduct surveys on suppliers to clarify the use of conflict minerals and refiners.
2. To address responsible procurement of mineral resources throughout the supply chain, we implement the procurement from refining companies certified by the EIC/GeSI CFS.
3. If the use of conflict minerals is found in our products, as soon as possible to eliminate them take appropriate action.
4. In order to eliminate conflict minerals, actively adopt those when and if more effective methods being established, we will consequently promote procurement in accordance with the entire supply chain.
